Boys/Girls Uniform

Black or grey trousers/skirt, white shirt/ blouse or white/yellow polo shirt and a green sweatshirt with school logo. A green fleece with the school logo may be worn. Black or brown sensible, waterproof school shoes should be worn at all times. In the summer term, the girls may prefer to wear white/green or white/yellow check dresses.

PE AND GAMES

A coloured 'house' t-shirt, black shorts, plimsolls and socks are required by all children for their PE lessons. Trainers must be worn to the field. In colder weather the children might like to wear a sweatshirt and tracksuit bottoms for their outdoor PE lessons. Football boots, long socks and shin pads will be needed for football. Years 3 4 5 & 6 will require a swimming costume and a towel for swimming lessons in Term 3 at Dover Leisure Centre.

The PE Kit should be kept in a named draw-string bag and hung on your child's peg in the cloakroom. It is important that your child has a PE Kit in school at all times.
